RENEW YOUR MIND, FOR THE TIME IS AT HAND.

My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my arrest by the Jewish leaders. But now my kingdom is from another place (John 18-36-NIV).

Jesus has finished the work the Father has given Him to do. He was about to accomplish the ultimate sacrifice for the redemption of Mankind. After praying in the garden of Gethsemane, He was arrested, and tried before the Sanhedrin, condemned and sent to Pilate the next morning (Mark 14:53-65). Before Pilate, when Jesus was questioned about His kingship, He gave the following answer:

- My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my arrest by the Jewish leaders. But now my kingdom is from another place (John 18-36-NIV).

The concern of the people living in the time of Jesus was wellbeing, prosperity, peace and happiness on this earth. As disciples of Jesus-Christ awaiting His kingdom of righteousness, should our hope rest on this world?

- surfeiting (overindulgence in worldly things, seeking for worldly things in excess),
- Drunkenness (carelessness regarding the things of God, being totally lost in the things of this world),
- the cares of this life (the concern about worldly things, careers, money, fame, worldly ambitions, , houses, success, positions, and the likes).

As we begin the journey in this new year, our prayer for you and ourselves is not to be conformed to this world but, to be transformed by the renewing of our mind, that we may prove what is good, acceptable and the perfect will of God, (Romans 12:2) especially in this time. We pray for God to bless you as you get very intentional in making God and His soon coming kingdom your priority.
